A few important pieces of information:

First Week

- The first day of school is Tuesday, September 7th and it is a half day: **8:45-11:55am**
- Students will be returning to their last year's class. Please have your child line-up in the same place as last year, except Nature K. Nature K students will line-up outside of your Nature K classroom.
- Our new 2021-2022 Kindergarteners will start school on Monday, September 13th with gradual entry. Their first full day of school is Wednesday, September 15th.
- Our school is at capacity, as are most of the schools in the district, therefore we will be waiting
 until later in the week to transition to new classes in order to capture as many new
 registrations as possible.
- Students will not need their school supplies until they transition to their new classes.

Health and Safety Protocols

- Masks are required for students in Grades 4 and 5, and are recommended for K-3
- We are no longer required to have cohorts or staggered recesses and arrival/release times
- We will return to all students playing outside first at lunch hour, and then eating second
- Handwashing protocols will be continued from last year
- Parents/guardians are able to walk with their children to their line-up, however we ask that adults maintain distance from other children/adults and that you leave the school property after drop-off
- Visitors wearing a mask are allowed entry into schools with an appointment. Please call the office at 250-478-4441.

- Daily health checks are required. If your child is sick, please keep them home until symptoms resolve

Pick-up and Drop-Off

- Busses will be running starting on Tuesday.
- Please try to walk or ride to school for pick-up and drop-off if possible
- Our staff has grown and all of our parking spaces are needed for staff, therefore we ask parents to find parking off-site and walk to school to pick-up. Please do not park in the Bakery/Convenience Store parking lot.
- In order to keep the flow of traffic, the parking lot will be used as a drive-thru area (only stopping to let children out safely). More information to come about this in the future.
