Principal's Report:

- Halloween dance was lots of fun
 - Out of approximately 270 students, about 60 students utilized designated "quiet spaces" as an alternative to the dance
- Art mural from last year has been put together and is in the school
 - Will be installed at front entrance in next week or so
 - Assembly unveiling the mural will be held December 8, 2023
- Remembrance Day ceremony was last week

- Mr. Poynter recorded the choir and whole school song with blurred out faces; links to be shared in school newsletter
- Learning conferences next Thursday, November 23
 - New this year from the Ministry: teachers can do informal updates however they would like to, at least twice per year
 - Families should have heard by now how learning communication will take place from their child(ren)'s teacher(s)
 - Report cards must be sent home by December 22, 2023; most will be available on MyEd
- Thursday will be our first Art Starts Performance; "How the Raven Stole the Sun"
 - o Thank you to PAC for funding for this performance
- Diwali is being celebrated in all classrooms and during library time
- Crosswalk at Lagoon and Metchosin intersection continues to raise concern
 - Crossing guard and slow down signs are a positive safety addition
 - o Reminders for traffic not to turn right or left while crossing guard is in the road
- This year's food drive will combine with Royal Bay's 10 000 Tonight initiative
 - o Donations will be collected in classrooms November 16 to 28
 - All donations will go to the Goldstream Foodbank
- All toilets in the building are functioning properly again this week after some closures and maintenance last week
- Grade 5 end of year trip; Ms. Gervais and Ms. Arnott would like to use one of the remaining scheduled bottle drives (January 6 or April 6) to fundraise for their trip
 - PAC executive voted yes to allow Grade 5 teachers and families to take over one of these dates; which date TBD
 - PAC will still sell Krispy Kreme doughnuts during each bottle drive, with funds raised going to PAC
- Giving Store
 - December 4, 2023 all day
 - o 3:30pm-6pm open to community
 - o Set up will start Friday, December 1 after 2:15pm
 - Donations are currently being collected in bins at front entrance and under covered area of school
- In the news: Ruth King and David Cameron will be getting portables
 - New South Langford school will open in approx. 1.5 years
 - Sangster could get up to 3 portables next year; could become an "overflow school"
 - We won't know for sure until February 2024
- Gaga ball pit installation delayed due to portable placement
- Family Dance date changed to Thursday, February 15, 2024
 - o Pro-D day the next day, then Family Day long weekend
- Holiday Concert scheduled for December 21 (afternoon and evening show)
 - o PAC to raffle "best seats in the house" and 50/50 draw
 - Will be ticketed event due to very limited space

 - Vote to approve change of date; approved
- Idea: Drop in sports nights for community
 - o PAC would rent Sangster's gym
 - o Community members pay to drop in to play hockey, basketball, etc
- Idea: 50/50 at a Royals game
 - Need 3 volunteers at each set of doors at SOF Memorial Centre (approximately 12 adult volunteers total for the evening)
 - Jess V will get list of possible dates so PAC can pick one

Hot Lunch

- Discussion regarding frequency of hot lunch dates; possibility of increasing to once per week?
 - Request from staff to keep it to biweekly due to increased excitement of students on hot lunch days
 - Desire to keep hot lunch as equitable and affordable as possible, so as many families can participate as possible
 - o Conesus to keep biweekly schedule for the time being
 - Option to simplify menu/offer pizza days more frequently (most cost effective)
